Does **Satan want us to know** what will happen in the end times?



And the angel of the Lord said unto me, Thou hast beheld that the book [BIBLE] proceeded forth from the mouth of a Jew; and when it proceeded forth from the mouth of a Jew it contained the plainness of the gospel of the Lord, of whom the twelve apostles bear record; and they bear record according to the truth which is in the Lamb of God:

Wherefore, these things go forth from the Jews in **purity** unto the Gentiles, according to the **truth** which is in God:

1 Nephi 3:165-175 (Cont.)→

And after they go forth by the hand of the twelve apostles of the Lamb, from the Jews unto the Gentiles, thou seest the **foundation of a great and abominable church**, which is most abominable above all other churches;

For behold, they have taken away from the gospel of the Lamb many parts which are plain and most precious;

And **also many covenants of the Lord** have they taken away;

1 Nephi 3:165-175 (Cont.)→

And all this have they done that they might pervert the right ways of the Lord; that they might blind the eyes and harden the hearts of the children of men:

Wherefore, thou seest that after the book hath gone forth through the hands of the great and abominable church that there are **many plain and precious things taken away from the book**, which is the book of the Lamb of God;

And after these plain and precious things were taken away, it goeth forth unto all the nations of the Gentiles:

1 Nephi 3:165-175 (Cont.)→

Thou seest because of the many plain and precious things which have been taken out of the book, which were plain unto the understanding of the children of men, according to the plainness which is in the Lamb of God;

Because of these things which are taken away out of the gospel of the Lamb, an exceeding great many do stumble, yea, insomuch that Satan hath great power over them;

Nephi 3:165-175

Summary of 1 Nephi 3:165-175:

- Bible was given in purity and truth
 - Plain and precious things were taken away

Why?

- To pervert the right ways of the Lord
- To blind our eyes
- To harden our hearts

Result:

- An exceeding great many of people do stumble
- Satan hath great power over people

Satan wants us ignorant of God's plan and he wants to destroy us



God wants us to know of His plan and to save all who will

God LOVES all people, everywhere, not just us!

21b And I give unto you a commandment, that you shall teach one another the doctrine of the kingdom; teach ye diligently and my grace shall attend you, that you may be instructed more perfectly in theory, in principle, in doctrine, in the law of the gospel, in all things that pertain unto the kingdom of God, that is expedient for you to understand;

21c of things both in heaven, and in earth, and under the earth; things which have been; things which are; things which must shortly come to pass;

21d things which are at home; things which are abroad; the wars and the perplexities of the nations; **and the judgments** which are on the land;

21e and a knowledge also of countries, and of kingdoms, **that ye may be prepared in all things** when I shall send you again, to magnify the calling whereunto I have called you, and the mission with which I have commissioned you.

22a Behold, <u>I sent you out to testify and warn the people</u>, and it becometh every man who hath been warned, to warn his neighbor; therefore, they are left without excuse, and their sins are upon their own heads.

22b He that seeketh me early shall find me, and shall not be forsaken.

23a Therefore, tarry ye, and labor diligently, that you may be perfected in your ministry, to go forth among the Gentiles for the last time, as many as the mouth of the Lord shall name, to bind up the law, and <u>seal up the testimony</u>, and to <u>prepare</u> the Saints for the hour of judgment, which is to come;

23b that their souls may escape the wrath of God, the desolation of abomination, which await the wicked, both in this world, and in the world to come.

- 2. He wants us looking for things that <u>will not</u> <u>happen</u>
- 3. He <u>twists the word of God</u> so we don't understand God's plan







Seven Years Tribulation Idea

The <u>tribulation</u> is a future time of world distress lasting seven years. The <u>Antichrist</u> will rule the world as a political and religious leader for the seven years. The first three and one half years will be a time of peace and prosperity. The Antichrist then puts an end to sacrifice and offering in the rebuilt temple.

Note: The temple in Jerusalem was destroyed and the belief is that it will be rebuilt and then destroyed again.



Seven Years Tribulation Idea

The last half of the <u>seven years</u> is a world holocaust never matched since the beginning of time. The Christian believers will be <u>raptured</u> out either in the beginning (pre-trib), middle (mid-trib) or after the seven years (post-trib).

Armageddon, the last big war, will bring an <u>end to this</u> world as we know it. <u>Christ will then come</u> again with His raptured saints to establish a Kingdom of God on earth called the millennium.



Seven Years Tribulation Idea

Scriptures people use to support 7 Years Tribulation:

- 1. <u>Daniel's vision in Daniel chapter 9</u>
 - Prophecy of seventy weeks and things that would happen during these weeks
- 2. New Testament (KJV or other version)
 - Jesus' prophecies of the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem, His return, and horrible things that would occur
- 3. The Book of Revelation
 - Talks about beasts, false prophets, calamities

Points of Reference Definition:

- landmark a mark showing the boundary of a piece of land
- target, mark a reference point to shoot at; "his arrow hit the mark"
- indicator a signal for attracting attention



Sources of our REFERENCE POINTS to understand prophecy

Restored Gospel Is Critical

- Inspired Version is absolutely needed to understand end-time concepts
 - Matthew 24, Mark 13 and Luke 21 are dramatically different in the KJV from the IV
- 2. Falling away and restoration of the gospel give us reference points for scriptures that others use for the idea of 7 years tribulation
 - See Book of Revelation covering 1,260 years or the 42 months (will touch on later)

But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit; for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? **even so the things of God knoweth no man, except he has the Spirit of God**...

But the <u>natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit</u> of God; for they are foolishness unto him; neither can he know them, <u>because they are spiritually discerned</u>.

1 Corinthians 2:10-14



God WANTS us to know and understand. He speaks in plainness to those who have His Holy Spirit.



Thou seest because of the many plain and precious things which have been taken out of the book, which were plain unto the understanding of the children of men, according to the plainness which is in the Lamb of God;

1 Nephi 3:174

Then the disciples came and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables? He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.

Matthew 13:9-10

15b yea, and I will also bring to light my gospel [BOM], which was ministered unto them, and, behold, they shall not deny that which you have received, but they shall build it up, and shall bring to light the true points of my doctrine; yea, and the only doctrine which is in me;

15c and this I do, that I may establish my gospel, that there may not be so much contention;

15d yea, <u>Satan doth stir up the hearts of the people to</u> contention, concerning the points of my doctrine; and in these things they do err, for they do <u>WREST</u> the Scriptures, and do not understand them;

Daniel 9 refers to 70 weeks

- = 70 weeks X 7 days/week
- = 490 days
- = **490** years

Revelation 13:5 refers to 42 months

- = 30 days/month X 42 months
- = 1,260 days
- = 1,260 years

- Revelation 12:14 refers to a time, times, and half a time (1 time = 1 year)
- = 1 year + 2 years + $\frac{1}{2}$ year
- $= 3\frac{1}{2}$ years
- = 360 years + 720 years + 180 years
- = 1,260 years

Revelation 12:5 states that this same period is 1,260 years (Inspired Version)



 - To rebuild
 - How much time until Messiah
 - Prophesies what the Messiah will do
 - Desolation to come upon Jerusalem (Jews)

Daniel 9:16-27

16 O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy mountain; because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people are become a reproach to all that are about us.

17 Now therefore, O our God, hear the prayer of thy servant, and his supplications, and cause thy face to shine upon thy sanctuary that is desolate, for the Lord's sake.


What was Daniel praying about in chapter 9?

VERY important to understand the context of his prayer.

16 O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy **city Jerusalem**, thy **holy mountain**...

20 And while I was speaking, and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the Lord my God for the **holy mountain of my God**;...

- 21 Yea, while I was speaking in prayer, even the man **Gabriel**, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being cause to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation.

70 weeks = 7 days X 70 weeks = 490 days = 490 years

25 Know therefore and understand, that from the <u>going forth</u> of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem, <u>unto</u> the Messiah the Prince, shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

NUMBERS:

Seven weeks + Threescore and two weeks

- = 7 (rebuild) + 60 + 2 weeks (until Messiah)
- = 69 weeks = 483 years



26 And after <u>threescore</u> and <u>two weeks</u> shall <u>Messiah be cut</u> <u>off</u>, but not for himself; and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determinable.

Summary:

Jesus shall be cut off after:

7 weeks (to build) from verse 25 +

62 weeks from verse 26 = 69 weeks or 483 years



27 And **he** shall <u>confirm the covenant with many for one</u> week; and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determination shall be poured upon the desolate.

NUMBERS:

7 weeks to rebuild + 62 weeks to Christ + 1 of covenant

= 70 weeks are determined upon the holy city



SUMMARY OF NUMBERS:

- 7 weeks (rebuild)
- + 62 weeks (until Messiah)
- + 1 week (he will confirm his covenant)
- = 70 weeks = 490 years

What is **COMMONLY** believed:

- After the 7 + 62 weeks is when Christ died or was "cut off"
- After that comes a prince of the people, "THE" anti-Christ

27 And he ("THE" anti-Christ) shall confirm the covenant with many for one week; and in the midst of the week, he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

What is **COMMONLY** believed:

- This one week for a covenant is the time of tribulation
- This one week of tribulation was put on hold until the last days







Two thing Daniel prophesied that Christ, the Messiah would accomplish:

- 1. Confirm the covenant
- 2. Cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease

Now this mediator was not a mediator of the <u>new</u> <u>covenant</u>; but there is one mediator of the <u>new covenant</u>, who is Christ, as it is written in the law concerning the promises made to Abraham and his seed...

Galatians 3:20

This is speaking of Christ and what HE would accomplish.

JESUS came to fulfill the law, to set men free from sin, to reconcile men to God, to bring about everlasting righteousness through the atonement, or his death on the cross, to fulfill the prophecies.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his Only Begotten Son, that whosoever believeth on him, should not perish; but have everlasting life.

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but **that the world through him might be saved**.

He who believeth on him is not condemned; but he who believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed on the name of the Only Begotten

What our church has taught:

- The woman in this vision is the church of God. She fled into the wilderness because of the persecutions of the beast
- This ushered in a period of 1,260 years where the church was not on the earth (dark ages)
- The dragon, which is Satan, gained power over the earthly kingdoms and gave power to the beast
- The woman, or church, was later restored by Jesus Christ himself through Joseph Smith



We know 1830 A.D., but why 570 A.D.?

So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness; and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet colored beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. And the **woman** was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication; And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND **ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.** And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus; and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. What our church has taught:

- The church was changed and true believers were persecuted and killed – resulting in a complete apostasy
 - A harlot took the place of the true bride of Christ (which is the church)
 - Book: "570 Early Christians from Apostles to Apostasy" by R. Ben Madison, M.A.
- Thus, there was a falling away from true belief in God, which is why the woman (the church) fled into the wilderness.
- This is the start of the timing when the beast was given power and when the mark of the beast would be instituted with unchallenged power

What our church has taught (cont.):

- The beast's heads and horns with crowns represented the nations in power around A.D. 570
- The little horn was Rome/Italy, the one that was wounded was brought back to life by the Bishop of Rome
 - meaning the government power was destroyed and the ecclesiastical power took over and brought Rome back to life (The Holy Roman Empire)
- In A.D. 570, the Bishop of Rome became the ecclesiastical and civil authority over the Roman government



- From A.D. 570, the church fell away from the earth and brought about the falling away where there was great famine for spiritual food and where the voice of God was not heard on the earth (for more on the falling away, see the Go Ye and Teach lesson on the Apostasy)
- Add 1,260 years (42 months, which is also a time, times, and half a time) to A.D. 570 and you get A.D. 1830





Satan does not want us ready:





Joseph of Egypt Seven Years Tribulation Theory:

Some who uphold the "seven year tribulation" theory get this belief from the "seven years of tribulation" that Joseph, son of Israel, told the Pharaoh of Egypt they were going to have.

This is the thing which I have spoken unto Pharaoh; What God is about to do he shows unto Pharaoh. Behold, there come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt; And there shall arise after them seven years of famine;

Genesis 41:28-30

People believe this is a type and a shadow of the concept of seven years tribulation

<u>Let's look at scriptures about the times near Christ's return:</u>

But of the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction comes upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. You are all the children of light, and the children of the day; we are not of the night, nor of darkness. **Therefore** let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be 1 Thessalonians 5:1-2 <u>sober</u>.

Other scriptures attest the fact that the Lord will "suddenly" come when people least expect it:

Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me; and the Lord whom you seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom you delight in; behold, he shall come, saith the Lord of hosts.

But as it was in the days of Noah, so it shall be also at the coming of the Son of Man. For it shall be with them as it was in the days which were before the flood; for until the day that Noah entered into the ark,

Conclusion to 7 Years Tribulation

7 Years Tribulation



In order to believe the 7 years tribulation:

- 1. Believe there is a 2,000 year gap between weeks 69 and 70 in Daniel chapter 9
- 2. Attribute the things that Christ will accomplish in Daniel's vision to the devil ("THE" anti-Christ)
- 3. Ignore that the 70 weeks were determined upon Jerusalem and not the whole world
- 4. Use the timeline of Christ's prophecy of His own return from the KJV instead of the Inspired Version

In order to believe the 7 years tribulation:

- 5. Incorrectly associate the Book of Revelation's "time, times, and half a time" to the end times
 - NOT recognize it as the time period of the apostasy (cornerstone belief of the Restoration)
- 6. Believe in THE "anti-Christ" which is not found in scripture (we will discuss next)
- 7. In Daniel believe a day = a year in prophecy, but in Revelation 12 & 13 believe that a day = a day

In order to believe the 7 years tribulation:

- 8. Disregard the Inspired Version and the revelation Joseph Smith received in D&C 45
- 9. Ignore the Restoration of God's Church and the Everlasting Gospel in 1830

End result: too many theories not founded in scripture.

We cannot believe in the Restoration and also believe in the theory of seven years tribulation







- 5. <u>II John 1:7</u> For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.
- 6. <u>Alma 16:7</u> But it came to pass in the latter end of the seventeenth year, there came a man into the land of Zarahemla; and he was antichrist, for he began to preach unto the people against the prophecies which had been spoken by the prophets concerning the coming of Christ.
- 7. <u>Alma 16:13</u> And this antichrist, whose name was **Korihor** (and the law could have no hold upon him,) began to preach unto the people, that there should be no Christ.

Search results (3): key word "false Christ":

- 1. <u>Matthew 24:22-23</u> And again, after the tribulation of those days which shall come upon Jerusalem if any man shall say unto you Lo! here is Christ, or there; believe him not, For in those days, there shall also arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if possible, they shall deceive the very elect, who are the elect according to the covenant.
 - Inspired Version clarifies that this is talking about the time of the destruction of Jerusalem and NOT about the time when Christ will return

Search results (3): key word "false Christ" (cont.):

- 2. <u>Mark 13:25</u> For in those days there shall also arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch, that if possible, they shall deceive the very elect, who are the elect according to the covenant.
- 3. <u>Words of Mormon 1:23</u> And it came to pass that after there had been false Christs, and their mouths had been shut, and they punished according to their crimes;...



Search results (1): key word "false Messiah":

1. <u>II Nephi 11:28-35</u> – And the Lord will set his hand again the second time to restore his people from their lost and fallen state. Wherefore, he will proceed to do a marvelous work, and a wonder among the children of men. Wherefore, he shall bring forth his words unto them, which words shall judge them at the last day; For they shall be given them for the purpose of convincing them of the true Messiah, who was rejected by them; (continued)...



Search results (1): key word "false Messiah" (cont.):

1. <u>II Nephi 11:28-35</u> – (continued) ...And unto the convincing of them that they need not look forward anymore for a Messiah to come, For there should not any come, save it should be a false Messiah, which should deceive the people: For there is save one Messiah spoken of by the prophets, and that Messiah is he who should be rejected of the Jews. Search results (3): key word "the false prophet":

- Revelation 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived the that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshiped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.



Search results (3): key word "the false prophet" (cont.):

3. <u>Revelation 20:10</u> – And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Notes:

- "The false prophet" title was introduced in Revelation 16:13
 as during the time of the 6th vial. However, this could also
 be the beast from Revelation 13:11-13 during the dark ages.
- Very little is given about what the false prophet would do other than deceive those who have the mark of the beast.
- Benjamin believes this could be the Papacy.

Antichrist (common attachment):

Antichrist against Christ, or an opposition Christ, a rival Christ. The word is used only by the apostle John. Referring to false teachers, he says (1 John 2:18, 22; 4:3; 2 John 1:7), "Even now are there many antichrists."

- This name has been applied to the "little horn" of the "king of fierce countenance" (Dan. 7:24-25; 8:23-25).
- 2. It has been applied also to the "false Christs" spoken of by our Lord (Matt. 24:5, 23-24).
- 3. To the "man of sin" described by Paul (2 Thess. 2:3-4, 8-10).
- 4. And to the "beast from the sea" (Rev. 13:1; 17:1-18).

Search results (1): key word "man of sin":

<u>II Thessalonians 2:1-10</u> – Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him, That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled by letter, except ye receive it from us; neither by spirit, nor by word, as that the day of Christ is at hand. Let no man deceive you by any means; for there shall come a falling away first, and that the man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshiped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God...And then shall that wicked one be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming... (continued)

"THE" anti-Christ

Search results (1): key word "man of sin" (cont.):

Il Thessalonians 2:1-10 – (continued) ... Yea, the Lord, even Jesus, whose coming is not until after there cometh a falling away, by the working of Satan with all power, and signs and lying wonders, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved...

Notes:

"Man of sin" is revealed in the falling away or apostasy which is during the 1,260 years

Thus, "the man of sin" is **NOT** someone who is yet to come as he was reveled during the apostasy. Could be the Papacy.

Conclusion

- Many references in scripture refer to the "spirit of antichrist" and not "THE" anti-Christ
- The beast and "the man of sin" are all descriptions of people/entities/things that Were introduced during the apostasy and NOT to rise up during the end times.
- "The false prophet" scriptures do not expressly connect him to other entities in other verses, however he could be associated with the beast from Revelation 13.
- We do expect antichrists to arise, as prophesied.
